

COAGULATE

Meaning: Coagulate: to change from a liquid to a thickened or solid state, often as a result of a chemical or physical process.

1. When blood vessels are injured, the body initiates a process to coagulate and stop the bleeding.
2. The chef instructed us to let the gelatin coagulate in the fridge before serving the dessert.
3. As the temperature dropped, the fat began to coagulate, giving the sauce a thicker consistency.
4. In certain medical conditions, the blood may coagulate too quickly, leading to the risk of clots.
5. The scientist observed how the proteins would coagulate when exposed to heat, forming a solid mass.
6. When exposed to air, the blood will quickly coagulate and form a protective scab.

12. When heated, the egg whites start to coagulate and turn firm.
13. Certain chemicals can cause the proteins in milk to coagulate, forming cheese.
14. To create a stable emulsion, the oil must coagulate with the egg yolk.
15. The laboratory test showed that the patient's blood did not coagulate properly, indicating a potential clotting disorder.

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
