Meaning: Coercitive (adjective): relating to or characterized by the use of force or intimidation to obtain compliance or control.

1. The government's coercitive measures sparked widespread protests among civil liberties advocates.
2. In negotiations, he employed coercitive tactics that left little room for compromise.
3. The coercitive nature of the policy undermined trust between the community and law enforcement.
4. Many viewed the decision to impose fines as a coercitive approach to enforce compliance.
