Meaning: Cognomination is the practice of assigning a second name or additional identifier to an individual, often reflecting lineage or social status.

1. The term "cognomination" refers to the practice of giving a second name or additional identifier to an individual.
2. In certain cultures, cognomination can signify lineage or social status.
3. Legal documents sometimes require cognomination to clarify an individual's identity.
4. The artist adopted a cognomination to distinguish her work from her family's well-known legacy.
5. During the naming ceremony, the child was given a cognomination that honored their grandparents.
