

# COLLODION

*Meaning: Collodion is a flammable, syrupy solution of nitrocellulose in ether and alcohol used in photography, particularly for coating glass plates in wet plate processes.*

1. The photographer carefully applied collodion to the glass plate to create a sharp image.
2. In the 19th century, collodion was a popular medium for wet plate photography.
3. After mixing the collodion with chemicals, the artist prepared to coat the canvas.
4. The unique texture of collodion gives a distinctive quality to the finished photographs.
