Meaning: Collodium is a viscous solution of nitrocellulose used in early photography to create images on glass plates.

1. The artist used collodium to create stunning photographic images in the 19th century.
2. Collodium, a viscous solution of nitrocellulose, was essential in early photography.
3. Many historic photographs were produced using the collodium wet plate process.
4. The inventor's use of collodium revolutionized the way portraits were captured.
5. Due to its flammable nature, working with collodium requires careful safety precautions.
