Meaning: Commensuratness refers to the quality of being proportionate or equivalent in value, significance, or contribution.

1. The commensuratness of their contributions ensured that everyone felt valued in the project.
2. In assessing the commensuratness of the two proposals, the committee prioritized fairness and equity.
3. The commensuratness of the rewards to the efforts put forth by the team was a key factor in their motivation.
