

COMPEAR

Meaning: To compear means to appear or present oneself in a specified place, especially in a formal context such as a stage or meeting.

1. The actors will compear on stage for the opening night of the play.
2. To compear before the committee, she prepared an extensive presentation.
3. He had no choice but to compear in court to answer the charges against him.
4. The witnesses were asked to compear and provide their testimonies during the trial.
5. It is customary for the finalists to compear at the awards ceremony to receive their honors.

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
