

COMPELLABLE

Meaning: COMPELLABLE: Adjective describing a person who can be legally required or compelled to testify or provide evidence in a court of law.

1. The evidence presented in court was compelling enough to make the witness compellable.
2. In certain legal contexts, a person may be deemed compellable to testify against their own interests.
3. The judge ruled that the documents were compellable and must be produced for the trial.
4. Due to the nature of the investigation, several witnesses became compellable under the new law.
