Meaning: COMPLICE: A person who assists or participates in the commission of a crime.

1. The detective suspected that the quiet neighbor was the criminal's accomplice.
2. During the trial, evidence revealed that the defendant had a willing accomplice in the robbery.
3. She felt guilty for being an accomplice in the scheme, even if she had not been the one to commit the crime.
4. The police managed to apprehend the main suspect, but the accomplice remained at large.
5. It was clear that the plan could not have succeeded without the help of an experienced accomplice.
