Meaning: Concession: a compromise or agreement made during negotiations, often involving a concession of demands or terms by one or more parties.

1. The company made a concession to the union by agreeing to a small wage increase.
2. After hours of negotiation, the two parties reached a concession that satisfied both sides.
3. He viewed his decision to apologize as a necessary concession to maintain peace in the family.
4. In the debate, she offered a concession on her initial stance to gain support from moderates.
5. The city's concession to build a new park was welcomed by the community as a positive step forward.
