Meaning: Conclusory refers to statements or claims that are based on conclusions rather than substantial evidence or reasoning.

1. The judge dismissed the case due to the conclusory nature of the evidence presented.
2. Her argument was criticized for being overly conclusory without substantial support.
3. In academic writing, it is essential to avoid conclusory statements that lack detailed explanation.
4. The report was filled with conclusory remarks that failed to address the underlying issues.
