

CONCORDAT

Meaning: A concordat is a formal agreement or treaty between the church and a government regarding their mutual relations and cooperation, particularly in social or educational matters.

1. The government signed a concordat with the religious organization to ensure mutual support on social issues.
2. The historical concordat between the church and the state fundamentally shaped the country's education system.
3. During the negotiations, both parties sought a concordat that would address their key concerns without compromising their core values.
