

CONCREMATION

Meaning: Concremation is the process of transforming offerings or remains into a sacred or durable substance through a specific ritual or method.

1. The ancient ritual of concretization involved a unique process called concretmation, where offerings were transformed into sacred substances.
2. During the process of concretmation, the remnants of the deceased were carefully transformed into a durable material.
3. In some cultures, concretmation is considered a way to ensure that the spirit lives on in a tangible form.
4. The artist used the concept of concretmation to create sculptures that represented the fusion of life and death.
5. Concretmation, though not widely practiced today, was once a revered method of honoring loved ones after their passing.

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
