Meaning: Concretively: in a manner that is specific, tangible, and clearly defined, often through the use of detailed examples or representations.

1. The architect presented her ideas concretively, using detailed drawings and models.
2. In the workshop, the participants were encouraged to express their thoughts concretively for clearer understanding.
3. The teacher emphasized the importance of discussing theories concretively to enhance student engagement.
