

CONDENSATION

Meaning: Condensation is the process by which water vapor in the air cools and transforms into liquid water, often forming droplets on surfaces.

1. Condensation forms on the outside of a cold glass of water when warm, humid air comes into contact with it.
2. The scientist observed the condensation on the surface of the test tube as the temperature dropped.
3. During the night, the condensation on the grass created a sparkling layer of dew in the morning light.
4. In the winter, condensation can lead to mold growth if not properly managed within the home.
5. The process of condensation is crucial in the water cycle, helping to form clouds from water vapor.
