Meaning: Condone: appropriate or deserved, particularly in relation to punishment or recognition.

1. The judge delivered a condign sentence that matched the severity of the crime.
2. Her efforts in the project received condign recognition from her peers and superiors alike.
3. The condign punishment for his actions ensured that he would never repeat his mistakes.
4. It was clear that the group's condign response to the crisis demonstrated their commitment to accountability.
