Meaning: Conditionally: in a manner that is dependent on certain conditions or stipulations being met.

1. She agreed to help conditionally, dependent on the project's funding.
2. The contract was signed conditionally, pending the approval of the board.
3. He will participate in the meeting conditionally, as long as his schedule permits.
4. They offered the promotion conditionally, subject to a successful performance review.
5. The deal was finalized conditionally, with specific terms that needed to be met.
