Meaning: Condonation is the act of overlooking or forgiving an offense or wrongdoing, often implying tacit approval or acceptance.

1. The judge's decision was seen as a condonation of the defendant's earlier misdeeds.

3. In the context of their relationship, she viewed his silence as a condonation of his partner's questionable choices.
