Meaning: Condone: to accept or allow behavior that is considered morally wrong or offensive to continue without criticism or punishment.

1. She refused to condone any form of cheating in her classroom.
2. The manager will not condone lateness during important meetings.
3. Many people believe that to condone violence is to perpetuate a cycle of harm.
4. It is difficult to condone his behavior, even under extreme circumstances.
5. The committee decided to condone the minor infraction after reviewing the circumstances.
