

CONDYLOID

Meaning: Condyloid refers to a type of synovial joint that allows for movement in two planes, permitting flexion, extension, and circular motion, as seen in the wrist joint.

1. The condyloid joint in the human wrist allows for a greater range of motion than a simple hinge joint.
2. In anatomy class, we studied the structure and function of the condyloid joint, which connects the forearm to the hand.
3. The condyloid joint is characterized by its oval-shaped surface that permits movement in two planes.
4. Common examples of condyloid joints include the joint at the base of the thumb and the joint between the radius and the carpal bones.
5. Understanding the mechanics of the condyloid joint can help in diagnosing certain types of injuries.

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
