

CONFABULATING

Meaning: Confabulating refers to the act of engaging in conversation or storytelling, often involving the creation of imagined or distorted memories presented as truth.

1. The children were confabulating about their summer adventures, weaving together stories filled with imagination.
2. During the therapy session, he began confabulating details of his past that he believed to be true but were actually fabricated.
3. She caught herself confabulating a tale about her travels, despite never having left her hometown.
4. The researchers noted that the subjects were confabulating instances from their lives, mixing reality with fantasy.
5. As they sat around the campfire, the friends started confabulating ghost stories, each one more elaborate than the last.
