

CONFIRMANCE

Meaning: Confirmance is the act of obtaining approval or agreement from relevant authorities or parties.

1. The architect sought confirmance from the city council before proceeding with the new design.
2. In legal terms, confirmance is essential to ensure that all parties are in agreement with the terms of the contract.
3. The scientist required additional data to establish confirmance with the initial hypothesis.
4. After reviewing the document, she signed it as a confirmance of her acceptance of the terms.
5. The committee met to discuss the confirmance of the new policy changes proposed by the board.
