

CONFISCATE

Meaning: To confiscate means to take possession of something, often by authority, typically as a penalty or to prevent misuse.

1. The school decided to confiscate the students' phones during the exam to prevent cheating.
2. Customs officials may confiscate any items deemed illegal or prohibited upon entry into the country.
3. After discovering the hidden stash, the police had no choice but to confiscate the drugs from the suspect.
