

CONFISCATION

Meaning: Confiscation is the act of taking or seizing someone's property, typically by a government authority, often without compensation.

1. The confiscation of illegal drugs from the warehouse was a significant victory for the police department.
2. Many argued that the confiscation of private property without just compensation was unconstitutional.
3. After the raid, the authorities announced the confiscation of several unregistered firearms.
4. Confiscation of assets is often a controversial measure in combating organized crime.
5. The sudden confiscation of the artist's work left the gallery in a state of shock and disarray.
