Meaning: Confusability refers to the degree to which similar items, such as words or phonemes, can be mistaken for one another, often leading to misunderstandings or errors in communication.

1. The confusability of similar-sounding words can lead to misunderstandings in spoken communication.
2. In linguistics, researchers study the confusability of phonemes to improve speech recognition technology.
3. A high degree of confusability between certain terms can complicate the learning process for language students.
4. The confusability factor in the experiment revealed how easily participants mixed up the two concepts.
5. To reduce confusability, the teacher clarified the differences between the two related theories.
