

CONGLOBULATE

Meaning: Conglobulate: to gather or cluster together to form larger masses or spherical shapes.

1. The scientist observed how the particles seemed to conglobulate into larger masses under the microscope.
2. In the heated solution, the tiny droplets began to conglobulate, forming a thick, viscous layer on the surface.
3. The artist used the technique to conglobulate different materials, creating a unique texture in her sculpture.
4. As the clouds gathered, they seemed to conglobulate, promising a heavy downpour later in the day.
5. The biologist noted that the bacteria would conglobulate when exposed to certain environmental stressors, forming protective clusters.
