

CONIDIUM

Meaning: Conidium is an asexual reproductive structure in fungi that produces spores.

1. The conidium serves as an asexual reproductive structure in many fungi.
2. Researchers observed that the conidia of the species produced a striking variety of colors.
3. Under the microscope, each conidium was clearly delineated and distinct from the others.
4. The formation of conidia allows for rapid dissemination of fungal spores in the environment.
5. In the laboratory, we cultured the fungus to study the morphology of its conidia.

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
