

CONJECTURALLY

Meaning: In a manner based on conjecture or speculation rather than firm evidence.

1. The hypothesis was conjecturally supported by the preliminary data, although further research was needed.
2. She conjecturally proposed that the new theory could explain the anomalies observed in the experiment.
3. The scientist conjecturally estimated the age of the fossil based on its surrounding strata.
4. Conjecturally speaking, the changes in climate could lead to significant shifts in migration patterns.
5. The results were conjecturally linked to the recent policy changes affecting the industry.
