

CONSCRIBE

Meaning: To conscribe means to enlist or draft individuals, typically young men, into military service, often during times of war or national crisis.

1. The government decided to conscribe young men for military service during the crisis.
2. In times of war, it is not uncommon for nations to conscribe citizens to bolster their armed forces.
3. She was taken aback when she received a notice stating that she could be conscribed for national duty.
4. The historical records reveal how many were conscribed against their will during the conflict.
