

CONSIGNATARY

Meaning: Consignatory: a person or entity to whom goods are consigned for delivery or handling, typically in the context of shipping or international trade.

1. The consignatory received the shipment promptly after it arrived at the port.
2. In international trade, the consignatory is responsible for ensuring that goods are properly handled.
3. The contract specified that the consignatory would take ownership of the cargo once it was unloaded.
4. Disputes often arise when the consignatory fails to inspect the goods upon delivery.
5. Each consignatory must provide accurate documentation to facilitate customs clearance.
