

CONSIGNATURE

Meaning: Consignature: a signature or endorsement that confirms agreement or acknowledgment in a consignment transaction.

1. The consignment of goods was finalized with both parties providing their consignature.
2. To ensure the authenticity of the document, a consignment with a consignature was required.
3. Her consignature on the agreement indicated her acceptance of the terms laid out.
4. In legal contexts, a consignature can serve as a binding affirmation of an agreement.
5. The absence of a consignature from one party raised concerns about the validity of the contract.

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
