Meaning: Consignee: A person or entity designated to receive goods delivered under a shipping agreement.

1. The consignee accepted the delivery of the goods after inspecting the packaging.
2. In international trade, the consignee is often responsible for paying customs duties.
3. The shipping documents listed the consignee's address as the final destination for the package.
4. A discrepancy in the consignee's information can lead to delays in shipment.
