Meaning: Consignee: the individual or entity designated to receive goods in a shipment, especially in the context of international trade.

3. Problems can arise if the consignee is unavailable to accept the delivery at the scheduled time.
4. The contract clearly states that the consignee bears responsibility for any damages incurred during transit.
5. Communication between the shipper and the consignee is crucial to prevent misunderstandings.
