

CONSIGNMENT

Meaning: Consignment refers to a shipment of goods delivered to a retailer or seller, who sells them on behalf of the owner and pays them a portion of the proceeds.

1. The boutique received a new consignment of handmade jewelry from local artisans.
2. She decided to sell her artwork on consignment at the gallery to reach a wider audience.
3. The consignment agreement outlined the terms for how the goods would be sold and profits divided.
4. After inspecting the consignment, the store owner was impressed by the quality of the furniture.
5. They arranged for the consignment to be shipped directly to the buyer's address once sold.
