

# CONSOLIDANT

*Meaning: Consolidant: a substance used to stabilize, strengthen, or preserve fragile materials, particularly in restoration or construction contexts.*

1. The scientist explained that the consolidant helps to stabilize the fragile artifacts during the restoration process.
2. In construction, a consolidant is often used to strengthen weak materials and prevent further deterioration.
3. The artist applied a consolidant to the painting to preserve its colors and protect it from environmental damage.
