

CONSOLS

Meaning: Consols are long-term government bonds that pay a fixed interest rate indefinitely and do not have a maturity date.

1. The government issued consols to finance the rebuilding of infrastructure after the disaster.
2. Investors were drawn to the stability of consols during times of economic uncertainty.
3. She inherited a portfolio that included consols from her grandfather, which provided a steady income.
4. The value of consols fluctuated with changes in interest rates, affecting many bondholders.
5. Historically, consols were perceived as a safe investment, especially during periods of war.
