Meaning: Constat (verb): To affirm or establish the existence or presence of something, often through observation or evidence.

1. The detective was able to constat the presence of fingerprints on the crime scene evidence.
2. During the meeting, she had to constat the discrepancies in the financial report.
3. He needed to constat the results of the experiment before proceeding to the next phase.
4. The teacher asked the students to constat their findings in a clear and concise manner.
5. After reviewing the data, the committee could finally constat the effectiveness of the new policy.
