

CONSTRINGE

Meaning: CONSTRINGE (verb): To constrict or compress, causing something to become smaller or tighter in response to external pressure or conditions.

1. The intense pressure from the surrounding walls began to constrict the balloon, causing it to lose air rapidly.
2. As the temperatures dropped, the metal would constrict, leading to potential structural issues.
3. The artist aimed to constrict the vast landscape into a single, powerful image that conveyed deep emotion.
