Meaning: Contention: a point of disagreement or argument in a debate or discussion.

1. The main contention in the debate was whether technology enhances or detracts from human interaction.
2. Her contention that the policy would lead to greater inequality sparked a heated discussion among the committee members.
3. Despite their contention over the budget, the team managed to collaborate effectively on the project.
4. The lawyer's contention was that the evidence presented was insufficient to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
5. In academic circles, his contention that traditional methods of teaching are outdated has gained considerable attention.
