

CONTOURNE

Meaning: Contourne (verb): To shape or define the outline of a figure or feature, often using shadows or makeup techniques to create a three-dimensional effect.

1. The artist skillfully used shadows to contourne the figure, giving it a three-dimensional appearance.
2. In the makeup tutorial, she demonstrated how to contourne the cheekbones for a more sculpted look.
3. The landscape's natural contourne was enhanced by the soft glow of the setting sun.
4. To achieve a more dramatic effect, the designer decided to contourne the edges of the fabric with a contrasting color.
5. During the fitness class, the instructor focused on exercises that would contourne the body for a leaner silhouette.
