Meaning: CONTRADICTORILY: In a manner that expresses or involves conflicting or opposing ideas or statements.

1. She spoke contradictory information during the meeting, making it hard for everyone to follow her argument.
2. The results of the experiment were, contradictorily, both expected and surprising at the same time.
3. He claimed to value honesty, yet, contradictorily, he often exaggerated the truth in his stories.
4. The team's performance was, contradictorily, praised for its creativity while simultaneously criticized for its lack of structure.
5. Contradictorily, the weather forecast predicted sunshine, but a sudden storm rolled in unexpectedly.
