

CONTRAINDICANT

Meaning: Contraindicator refers to a condition or factor that serves as a reason to withhold a particular treatment or medication due to potential harm.

1. Certain medical conditions can be contraindicator to the use of specific medications.
2. The doctor's refusal to prescribe the treatment was based on its contraindicator effects on her health.
3. Before starting any new therapy, it is essential to identify any contraindicator factors in the patient's history.
4. The presence of severe allergies was a contraindicator consideration for the proposed surgical procedure.
5. In this case, the patient's age was deemed a contraindicator factor in administering the experimental drug.
