

CONTRAINDICATION

Meaning: Contraindication: a specific reason or condition that makes a particular treatment or medication inadvisable or unsafe for a patient.

1. Patients with a known allergy to penicillin have a clear contraindication for its use.
2. The physician reviewed the patient's medical history to identify any potential contraindications before prescribing the new medication.
3. In the presence of liver disease, the drug has a contraindication due to its potential for toxicity.
4. It's crucial to disclose any contraindications to your healthcare provider to avoid serious complications.
5. Certain heart conditions may present a contraindication for participating in high-intensity exercise programs.

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
