Meaning: To controvert means to argue against or challenge a statement, belief, or claim, often by presenting evidence or reasoning that contradicts it.

1. The scientist's findings were so groundbreaking that they were bound to controvert long-held beliefs in the field.
2. In the debate, she attempted to controvert his claims by presenting new evidence that contradicted his argument.
3. The historian's controversial book aimed to controvert the traditional narrative of the war.
4. To controvert the accusations made against him, he provided a detailed account of his whereabouts that day.
5. Many experts believe that the new study will controvert previous assumptions about climate change.
