

CONTUSE

Meaning: To contuse means to injure a part of the body, typically resulting in a bruise, without breaking the skin.

1. The athlete managed to contuse his arm during the intense match, leaving a visible bruise.
2. While hiking, she slipped and fell, which caused her to contuse her ankle.
3. The doctor explained that a contused muscle might take longer to heal than a simple strain.
4. He was careful not to contuse his ribs while practicing dangerous stunts on his bike.
5. After the accident, the paramedic noted that the patient's injuries included a contused thigh.
