

CONVECTIVELY

Meaning: Convectively: in a manner relating to the transfer of heat or moisture through the movement of fluids, typically involving rising warm air and sinking cooler air.

1. The storm intensified as warm air was lifted convectively, leading to heavier rainfall.
2. In the atmosphere, heat is distributed convectively, creating powerful updrafts and downdrafts.
3. The meteorologist explained how the clouds formed convectively, resulting in a rapid change in weather.
4. During the summer months, thunderstorms often develop convectively due to rising surface temperatures.
5. Convectively driven systems are known to produce severe weather patterns, including tornadoes and hail.
