

CONVENTIONALISM

Meaning: Conventionalism is the belief that social norms and established practices dictate moral values and artistic expression, often limiting creativity and innovation.

1. Conventionalism often stifles creativity and innovation in artistic expression.
2. The philosophy of conventionalism argues that social norms shape our understanding of morality.
