

CONVULSE

Meaning: To convulse means to experience sudden, violent, and uncontrollable movements or spasms, often associated with intense emotion or physical distress.

1. The dramatic scene caused her to convulse with laughter, unable to control her amusement.
2. Witnesses reported seeing the animal convulse in distress after being startled by the loud noise.
3. During the seizure, his body began to convulse violently, prompting immediate medical attention.
4. The unexpected shock made her heart convulse with fear, leaving her momentarily frozen in place.
5. He struggled to keep his composure as the memories of the past seemed to convulse within him, threatening to overwhelm his senses.
