

CORNEOUS

Meaning: Corneous: having a tough, horn-like texture or structure, typically providing protection.

1. The corneous exterior of the turtle's shell provides excellent protection against predators.
2. Some species of fish have developed corneous plates that help them withstand harsh environments.
3. The corneous structure of the horn is essential for the animal's survival in its natural habitat.
4. In certain reptiles, the corneous scales serve as both armor and a means of regulating body temperature.
5. Botanists have noted that the corneous coating on some seeds aids in their dispersal and germination.
