

# CORONOID

*Meaning: Coronoid refers to a projection or process on a bone, particularly the coronoid process of the mandible, that serves as an attachment point for muscles or ligaments.*

1. The coronoid process of the mandible serves as an important attachment point for the temporalis muscle.
2. In anatomical studies, the coronoid feature of bones can provide insights into evolutionary adaptations.
3. During the surgical procedure, the surgeon carefully navigated around the coronoid to avoid damaging surrounding nerves.
4. The coronoid region of the ulna plays a crucial role in the stability of the elbow joint.
5. Researchers noted that variations in the size of the coronoid can influence jaw mechanics in certain species.
